

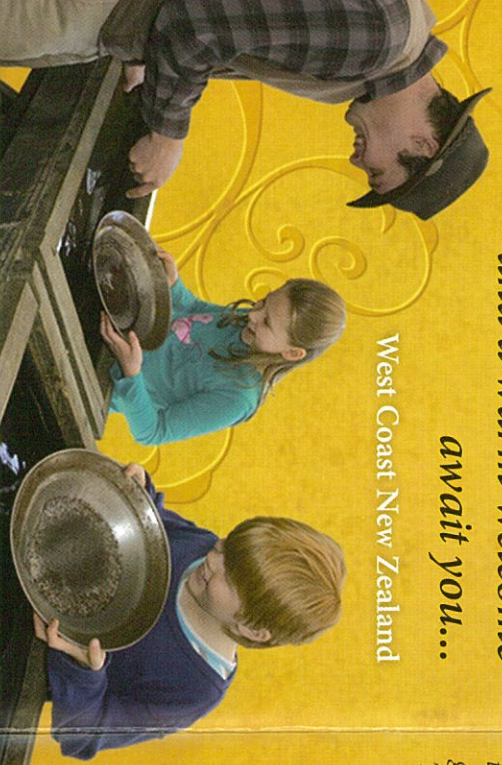

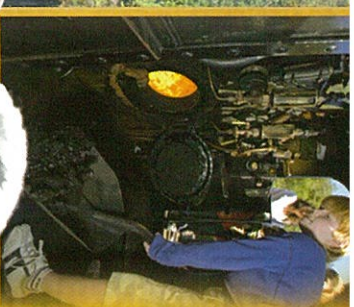
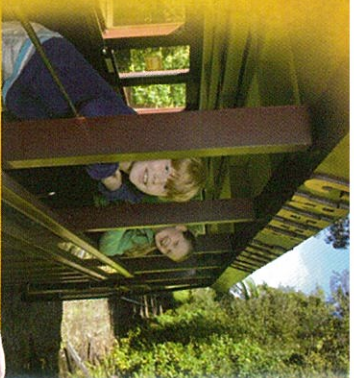

STEAM TRAINS

Two fully restored steam locos work the Infants Creek Bush Tramway. Take a 20 minute trip with a stop for photos, talk to the drivers and inspect the cab. Departs hourly.



CHINATOWN

By the mid 1870s Chinese made up the largest minority group on the West Coast goldfields. Chinatown reflects the way of life of these pioneers, built in recognition of the significant contribution they made to the West Coast's gold rush. Explore their houses and a short gold miners' tunnel.



GOLD PANNING/SLUICE GUN

Watch the mighty Sluice Gun in action as it blasts gold bearing rock and sand down the races.

Follow the races and flumes to the Gold Claim where our expert Gold Mining Team will tutor you to pan for your own gold – a strike is guaranteed! Trade your gold in the village.



SAWMILL

Experience the sights and sounds of a working sawmill and read stories of real characters from the area.

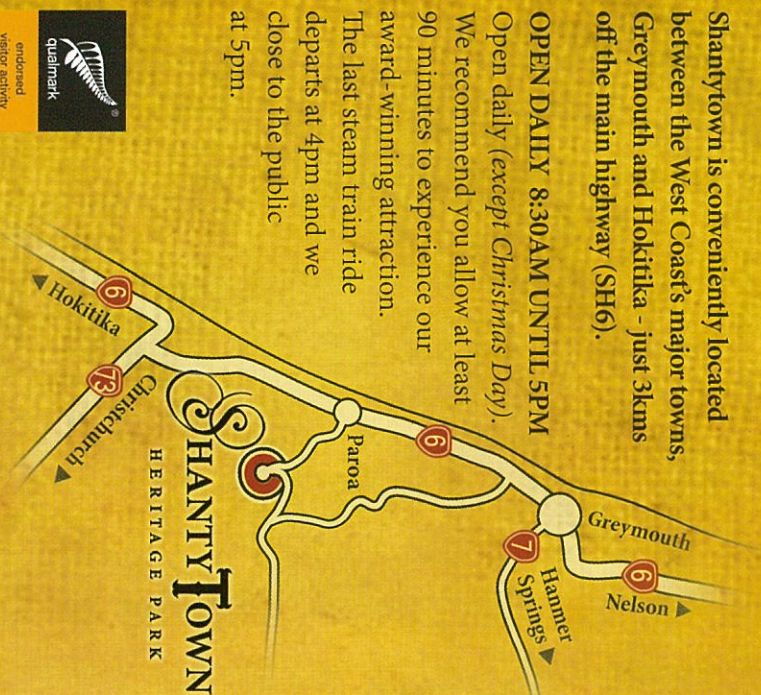
Shantytown is conveniently located between the West Coast's major towns, Greymouth and Hokitika - just 3kms off the main highway (SH6).

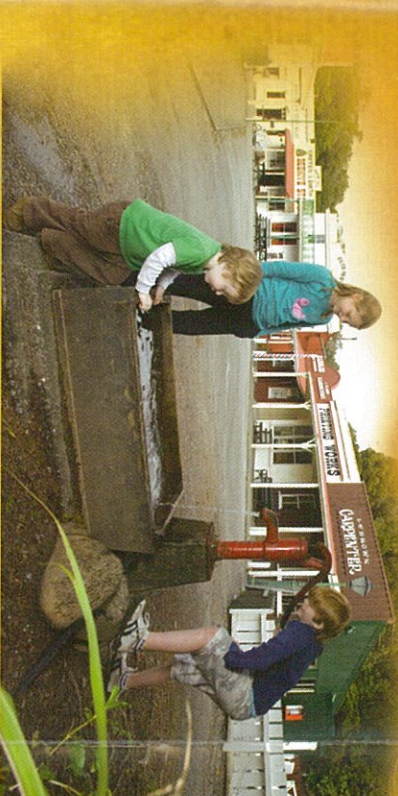

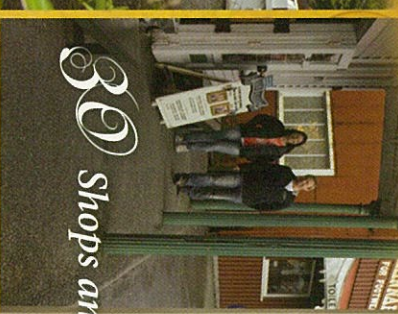
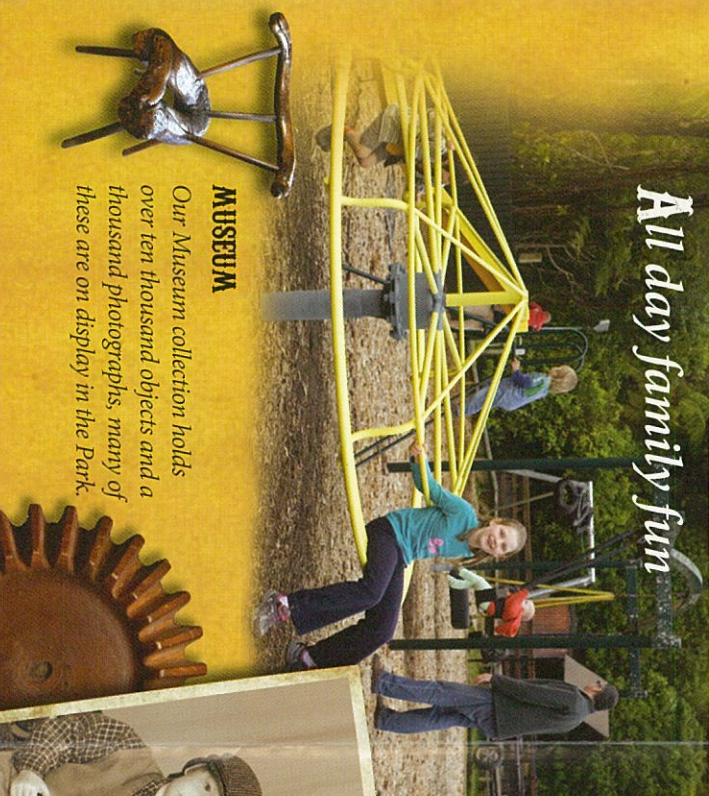
