



### STEAM TRAINS

Two fully restored steam locos work the Infants Creek Bush Tramway. Take a 20 minute trip with a stop for photos, talk to the drivers and inspect the cab. Departs hourly.



### CHINATOWN

By the mid 1870s Chinese made up the largest minority group on the West Coast goldfields. Chinatown reflects the way of life of these pioneers, built in recognition of the significant contribution they made to the West Coasts gold rush. Explore their houses and a short gold miners' tunnel.




### GOLD PANNING/SLUICE GUN


## HERITAGE PARK

Shantytown is conveniently located between the West Coast's major towns, Greymouth and Hokitika - just 3kms off the main highway (SH6).

The last steam train ride departs at 4pm and we close to the public at 5pm.


